

★ VICTORY CHIMES BY DONALD DEMERS ★

The artist who has a keen knowledge of the particular subject he is painting brings to the palette an interpretation born of intimacy. As a boy Donald Demers was visiting his grandfather in Booth Bay when he saw a three-masted schooner named Victory Chimes sail into the harbor. He jumped into the back of his grandfather's truck and sketched the schooner. He soon became a sailor crewing aboard the Square-rigged *Unicorn*, the Schooner *Fair Sarae*, and Brigantine *Black Pearl*. Donald Demers, for the past quarter century, has been a marine artist. The same hands that hauled on halyards to raise canvas have manipulated the artist's brush to create on canvas. A "fellow" of the **American Society of Marine Artists**, his maritime paintings have been featured in numerous maritime publications like **Marine Boats and Harbors**, **Nautical Quarterly**, **Nautical World**, **Offshore magazine** and **Yachting magazine**. His award-winning work has been featured in a

half dozen books, and he has done work for the National Parks Service. He will be featured in an upcoming Public Television series called "**The Outdoor Studio.**"
